Scabies is a very itchy skin condition caused by the Scabies Mite that burrows into the skin to lay eggs. Above the eggs, small blisters will appear on the skin. These mites are extremely contagious and can be passed on through physical contact and wearing other people's hats. If your tamaiti/child is infected with Scabies, please seek medical treatment.
